designermakers21 is a unique, co-operative project so a collaborative approach is expected.

As a temporary member -

You will have a studio space in designermakers21 for a period of 3 months.

You are required to pay rent in advance at the beginning of every month of £75/ month + £5/ month for the kitty (to purchase tea/coffee etc)

Temporary members rent a key for £25 which is refunded at the end of the 3 month period once the key has been returned. You are able to use your studio space whenever you like.

designermakers21 is open to the public every Thursday, Friday and Saturday. We try to be here as much as possible on these days so that we can talk to visitors about our crafts and sell our work.

You will need to have your own Public Liability insurance, if you need any assistance with this please let us know.

Temporary members do not have a guaranteed display space in the window as this depends on when the windows are being changed. They do have a space to display in the main galleries with information about yourself and what you do. There is no added commission on the sales of your work while at the studio.

Temporary members are not required to contribute to our cleaning and opening rotas. You are welcome to attend our meetings which happen every fortnight on a Friday from 4pm but will be unable to vote.

You are welcome to get involved in the space, we would value your ideas and input. If you would like to have a slot on the front desk to see what happens in selling and talking with customers this can be arranged with Annette.

At the end of your 3 month membership we ask for a written feedback of your experience.
